The Las Vegas Metropolitan Area spans 135.9 square miles, including Las Vegas, North Las Vegas, Henderson, Boulder City, Mesquite, and nearby unincorporated communities. Downtown Las Vegas, known as Glitter Gulch, features historic casinos and the Fremont Street Experience—a five-block pedestrian mall with dazzling light shows.

The world-famous Las Vegas Strip, located just south of downtown, is a 4.5-mile stretch of neon-lit casinos themed after landmarks like the Eiffel Tower, Egyptian pyramids, and the New York skyline. It offers world-class entertainment, including Cirque du Soleil, gondola rides, zip lines, and rollercoasters.

Beyond the city, Southern Nevada boasts stunning outdoor destinations like Red Rock Canyon, Mt. Charleston, the Valley of Fire, the Hoover Dam, and Lake Mead.

A significant portion of Las Vegas' newcomers, about one-third, hail from California, driving growth in industries like home construction, landscaping, and manufacturing. The Las Vegas Metropolitan Area has seen rapid population growth, increasing by at least 41% per decade since 1960, when the population was 167,000. Between 1990 and 2000, it was the fastest-growing metropolitan area in the U.S., with the 2010 census recording nearly 2 million residents and a projected 2020 population of 2.7 million.
